

RULES & CONDITIONS

TO BE RUN UNDER BRC RULES

1. Riding is a risk sport – **ALL COMPETITORS TAKE PART AT THEIR OWN RISK** and are expected to exercise due care at all times and to obey all notices placed for their control. The organisers and owners of the showground and facilities shall not be responsible or accountable in any way whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to exhibitors, their servants, agents, other members of the public, any animals, property or vehicles brought onto the showground or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or for anything else in conjunction with or arising out of, or attributable to the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the organisers blameless, and indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings. SPECTATORS, whether or not connected with competitors are also required to comply with the above conditions for their own safety.

2. **ALL ACCIDENTS/INCIDENTS/FALLS** shall be reported to the secretary (whether or not first aid attention was required) and assistance must be given in recording the event in the accident/incident book. The BHRC recommend that all competitors should have adequate personal sports insurance.

3. **IN ALL MATTERS THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.** Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary's within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit. If on investigation by the Show Committee the objection is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the show.

4. **DRESS – HARD HATS** to comply with the current British Standard with chinstraps fastened and **SUITABLE FOOTWEAR** must be worn at all times when mounted. **SPURS** are **NOT PERMITTED** in any class, however, dummy spurs may be worn. **SHOWING CANES/WHIPS NOT TO EXCEED 30 inches** in length, excepting side saddle entries. **JUNIORS 18 YEARS & UNDER** must wear **HARD HATS** (as specified above) when competing in-hand.

5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel, change, amalgamate, close classes or change the judge at their discretion. No refund will be given if classes are missed.

6. **HORSES MUST NOT BE GALLOPED OUTSIDE THE RINGS.** Please work-in in the designated areas. Anyone riding or handling a horse/pony in a manner that is considered by the organisers to endanger the safety or well being of any horse, pony, rider, spectator or official will be asked to leave the showground.

7. **NO HORSES/PONIES TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED TIED TO THE OUTSIDE OF BOXES OR TRAILERS.**

8. Any person using physical or verbal abuse against any committee member, judge, steward, official or helper will be asked to leave the showground and banned from entering the show in the future.

9. Any ridden horse or brood mare is to be at least 4yrs old and foals must be at least 3 weeks old. All ridden equines must be 4 yrs & over.

10. **STALLIONS & COLTS** that are 2yrs old and over must be in possession of a current licence (unless otherwise governed by their individual society) and be shown bitted. **IN-HAND - STALLIONS & COLTS** may not be led by any junior who has not attained their 14th birthday#. **RIDDEN - STALLIONS not exceeding 138cm** may not be ridden by any junior who has not attained their 12th birthday#. **STALLIONS exceeding 138cm** may not be ridden by any junior who has not attained their 14th birthday#. (# by 1st January in the current year)

11. All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday before 1st January in the current year. All ages to be taken as on the day of the show unless otherwise stated. All junior riders may be required to produce a birth certificate.

12. All dogs must be kept on leads.

13. Qualifiers for *SOUTH WEST PONY ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIPS* & TSR. Recipients of cards must comply with the general rules of *SWPA* and rules for Championship section or appropriate TSR rules

CLASS 1 - YOUNGSTOCK - OPEN QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS & TSR
Yearlings, Two & Three Year Olds - May be split into age groups if sufficient entries

CLASS 2 - MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS(M) & TSR
To be registered with the appropriate society and shown in accordance with the rules of that society -
May be split Small/Large if sufficient entries

CLASS 3 - COLOURED HORSE or PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (D) & TSR
To include Piebald, Skewbald, Spotted, Appaloosa, Palomino & Dun

CLASS 4 - OPEN HORSE QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (B, E, X) & TSR
Exceeding 148cms (Exhibitors in this class may not enter class 5)

CLASS 5 - OPEN PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (F, G, H) & TSR
Not exceeding 153cms (Exhibitors in this class may not enter class 4)

CLASS 6 - FOREIGN BREEDS / ARABS QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (A, W) & TSR
Any breed not native to the British Isles and their Part-Breds

CLASS 7 - COBS QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (C) & TSR
To include Show, Maxi, Traditional/Gypsy – To be shown unplaited

CLASS 8 - VETERAN HORSE or PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (V) & TSR
15 yrs and over

CLASS 9 - CHILD HANDLER QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (Y) & TSR
Handlers to have achieved their 6th birthday but not their 18th by the 1st January in the current year -
Class may be split if sufficient entries - No colts or stallions - Hard Hats to the current standard must
be worn for this class

CLASS 10 - BEST TURNOUT - OPEN
To include In-Hand & Ridden

CLASS 11 - NOVICE RIDDEN - OPEN QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (N, N1, N2, N3) & TSR
Horse or Pony not to have been placed 1st in any ridden class – Snaffle bridles to be worn

CLASS 12 - LEAD REIN PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (K A, B & C) & TSR
Riders 8yrs & under - *ROSETTE TO ALL ENTRIES*

CLASS 13 - VETERAN HORSE or PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (V1) & TSR
15 yrs and over. *SPECIAL ROSETTE TO OLDEST HORSE/PONY*

CLASS 14 - MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (M1) & TSR
To be registered with the appropriate society and shown in accordance with the rules of that society -
May be split Small/Large if sufficient entries

CLASS 15 - COLOURED HORSE or PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (D1) & TSR
To include Piebald, Skewbald, Appaloosa Spotted, Palomino & Dun

CLASS 16 - OPEN RIDDEN HORSE QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (A1, B1, E1, F1, W1, X1) & TSR
EXCEEDING 148 cms (Exhibitors in this class may not enter class 17)

CLASS 17 - OPEN RIDDEN PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (F1, G1, H1, H2) & TSR
Not exceeding 153cms (Exhibitors in this class may not enter class 16)

CLASS 18 - COBS QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (C1 & C2) & TSR
To include Show, Maxi, Traditional/Gypsy – To be shown unplaited

CLASS 19 - COMPETITION HORSE or PONY QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (R1 & R2) & TSR
May be split, Exceeding 148cm / Not exceeding 148 cm, if sufficient entries.

CLASS 20 - FOREIGN BREEDS / ARABS QUALIFIER FOR SWPA CHAMPIONSHIPS (A1, W1) & TSR
Any breed not native to the British Isles and their Part-Breds

QUALIFYING RULES

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships to be held IN 2019
at the David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Monmouthshire NP26 5XP

THESE CLASSES ARE OPEN TO EVERYONE.

However, if you qualify and wish to go the Championships you need to be a member of the SWPA and meet the qualification criteria of the SWPA

To qualify for the Championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card
4. Register on-line at www.showingscene.com within 14 DAYS of qualification
5. Upload this card using our on-line management system at www.showingscene.com

Please Note: Registration fee for 2018 is £30 to include all members of the family and equines owned by the family.

TSR SHOWING FINALS

This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR Showing Finals . Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals – Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West Or Scottish. You DO NOT have to be a TSR Member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR in Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand Class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.the-showing-register.co.uk>

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for TRS Medal – see TSR website for details
BSHA Grass Roots Champs. – With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs. In Sept at Addington EC – you do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See www.britishshowhorse.org
